Prairie Valley Parents,

Recently the Prairie Valley ISD school board, with the support of the administration and secondary faculty, voted to amend the way high school credit can be awarded.

Currently credit is awarded semester by semester. The board voted to give students who fail the fall semester only the ability to earn 1 credit if they pass the course in the spring and their overall average is a 70 or better. The exception to this is if a student passes in the fall and fails in the spring they cannot earn the whole credit. The following chart provides some examples:

THE ACCUMULATION OF CREDIT FOR A COURSE FAILED IN THE FALL SEMESTER

Fall Grade	Spring Grade	Average	Result
66	74	70	1 Credit Earned
90	66	N/A 78	.5 Credit Earned
60	76	68	.5 Credit Earned
