With a student to teacher ratio of 10:1, your child will benefit from small class sizes led by veteran teachers.

Our Junior High and High School classes have a ratio of 10:1, which fosters a close relationship between our experienced teachers and every individual student. We offer a multitude of athletic and academic extracurricular activities, dual credit courses, a variety of electives, and certification opportunities through our Career and Technology Programs such as Microsoft Certifications and Welding.

Some Prairie Valley ISD highlights include a significant technology update in the summer of 2017, and continuing through the 2018-2019 school year. We are continually enhancing the building, with adding air conditioning to the gym, updating classrooms, and adding murals and new paint throughout the building. Also, all Prairie Valley Students are offered Free Breakfast every morning, regardless of a student’s free or reduced status. We provide three bus routes in the mornings and afternoons. One picks up at our Town Stop, just north of Hoben Road on FM 103. Another runs to Lake Estates, Oak Shores, and through Nocona Hills. The third route runs north of school to our Spanish Fort area students.
