
Widespread flurries ending this afternoon

- Hazards for motorists
 - Slick roads
 - Low visibilities
 - Exposure to extreme cold
- You have today and tomorrow to get you, home, family, vehicles, etc ready


Dangerous Wind Chill

Lowest values expected Sunday through Tuesday mornings


