QUALIFICATIONS

PRAIRIE VALLEY HS GRADUATES

Must be a graduate of Prairie Valley Schools and attended PV for 4 consecutive years.

Must have exceptional achievement in their chosen field of endeavor at the local, state, or national level.

Must be of high character whose accomplishments have been recognized as significant, since their graduation, to Prairie Valley and their community.

Must have separation from PV for at least 10 years.

PRAIRIE VALLEY ISD RETIRED STAFF

Must have been retired or Prairie Valley ISD for 5 or more years prior to nomination and whose efforts have contributed significantly to the district.

Must have taught, worked, been an administrator, or board member at Prairie Valley ISD for 10 years or more.

Must have separation from PV for at least 5 years.

The award may be given posthumously.
